English Proficiency Graduation Requirements

- 1. NKUHT students must meet their Departments or Programs' graduation requirement for English proficiency. Please refer to your Department or Program guidelines for specifics.
 - Students with English proficiency certificates meeting their graduation requirement should submit their documents before Midterm Week of the second semester in senior year at https://register.nkuht.edu.tw. After submission, print out the form. Next, take the form and your original English certificate and a copy of the certificate to your Department or Program for verification. Finally, bring the documents to the Language Center for final approval.
- 2. The online English self-study system may be accessed at https://easytest.nkuht.edu.tw. Your account number and password are initially set as your student NKUHT (Portal) account number and password.
- 3. Remedial Measures
 - a. According to the NKUHT's 'English Proficiency Graduation Requirement' rules, students may take a Remedial English Language Proficiency Certification Course offered by the General Education Center during the second semester of senior year or during the second semester of the third year, if the student has internship during fourth year. Students need to pay the course fees. When they pass the Course Final Test with an equivalent score to their graduation requirement, they will be considered to meet their graduation requirement.
 - b. Freshmen and sophomores are not eligible to take the Remedial English Language Proficiency Certification Course.
- 4. For further details, consult the 'NKUHT Rules for 4-Year College English Language Proficiency Graduation Requirement' rules. (Language Center webpage/Downloads/Administration)

Waiving General Education (GE) English Courses

- 1. **Waive Requirements:** new students may waive GE English courses if they meet one of the following requirements.
 - a. An English proficiency test score equivalent to TOEIC 785 or higher from within the two years prior to entering NKUHT.
 - b. A (vocational) high school or higher diploma from an English-speaking country
- 2. **Waived Courses:** English Listening/Speaking I, English Listening/Speaking II, Workplace English, English Reading/Writing I, and English Reading/Writing II (Five courses, 10 credits)
- 3. Application Time: applications for waiver will only be accepted starting from the first day of the Fall semester through the first week of the Winter semester at NKUHT. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 4. **Application Submission:** First floor of the International Building (H Building) at the Foreign Language Section (H103).
- 5. For further details, consult the 'NKUHT Rules for Academic Credit Waiver for 4-Year College General Education English Courses' rules. (Language Center webpage/Downloads/Administration)

Guideline Governing the Rewards for Students' Achievement in English Proficiency Test

- 1. In order to encourage students to enhance their English ability and their competitiveness in the future, the school has specially formulated this guideline.
- 2. The targets for rewards in this Guideline are active students who have registered during the school term and have taken the English Proficiency Test listed in this Guideline and meet the reward standards at all levels.
- 3. The rewards of this Guideline are divided into two levels. (Please see website for details: Language Center webpage/Downloads/Students) Students may apply for the reward if they passed the standards in this Guideline in the current year and the previous year.
- 4. Only the students in the departments and programs which have set English graduation requirements could apply for the rewards in this Guideline.
- 5. Each student can apply for the reward once. Application from international students is limited to those who are from non-English speaking countries. Nevertheless, if a grant is received through the same certificate, then THIS VERY certificate is not allowed to file any application for rewards again.
- 6. Application time: Application is collected once every semester; the deadline for the Fall semester is November 30, and the deadline for the Winter semester is May 30. Late application will not be accepted.
- 7. Application Procedure: Students should fill in the application form, and attach the original English certificate and one extra copy, with a copy of a valid student ID with the registration stamp of the semester, and a copy of the cover page of their own passbook/bankbook. Then all the documents shall be sent to the Language Center for processing before the deadline. (Language Center webpage/Downloads/Students)
- 8. The amount and source of the funds for the rewards:
 - a. The total amount of rewards is based on the budget for the year.
 - b. The funds for this Guideline are covered by the MOE project subsidy or the annual budget of the school funds.

Notes on Mandarin Courses for International Students

International students who register for Mandarin Courses(note1) at NKUHT are assigned by Language Center based on their Chinese placement test results. International students must fill out an "Add/Drop Form" for their Mandarin Courses in the Language Center during the add/drop period at the beginning of the semester. However, students may add/drop a Mandarin Culture Course(note2) online or by coming to the Language Center for assistance.

- a. Freshman Students: For the first and second semesters, the Language Center will assign international students to proper Mandarin Courses based on their Chinese placement test results. International students who do not want to take a Mandarin Course must go to the Language Center to fill out an "Add/Drop Form" to drop the course.
- b. Sophomore, Junior, and Senior Students: International students who want to take a Beginning, Intermediate, or Advanced Mandarin Course need to fill out an "Add/Drop Form" in the Language Center.
- c. Mandarin Culture Courses: The courses are only available for international students who are in their sophomore, junior, and senior years.

- 1. Mandarin Courses: Basic Chinese, Intermediate Chinese, and Advanced Chinese
- 2. Mandarin Culture Courses: Taiwan Food Culture, Taiwan Folklore and Religion, Taiwan History and Geography,

Taiwan Popular Drama, Taiwan Modern Art, Contemporary Democratization in Taiwan, Applied Chinese in Restaurant and Culinary Arts, Applied Chinese in Tourism and Hotel, Pop Music Culture, Applied Mandarin for Hotel and Leisure, Current Affairs and international outlook, Applied Mandarin in Restaurant and Culinary Arts(I), Applied Mandarin in Restaurant and Culinary Arts(II), Drama and Film Culture, Applied Mandarin in Tourism.
